1

DAY 1: ARRIVAL TO EDINBURGH

Upon your arrival in **Edinburgh**, you will be greeted by a private driver who will take you to your hotel in the city centre. For those arriving early in the day, we recommend spending the day walking through the city, exploring the **Old Town** and New Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. There are also plenty of museums and landmarks to visit within the city centre, including the beautiful **St Giles Cathedral** and the majestic Edinburgh Castle.

Spend the night in Edinburgh.

Attractions: Calton Hill, Edinburgh, Edinburgh Castle, Edinburgh New Town, Edinburgh Old Town, The Grassmarket, The Royal Mile & St Giles Cathedral

2

DAY 2: A WALK THROUGH EDINBURGH'S PAST

You have the full day to delve deeper into Edinburgh's culture and history. Start the day with a private walking tour of the Old Town. You'll walk the narrow, cobbled streets and hear the lesser known tales of Edinburgh's ancient history.

Later, you could walk up the **Royal Mile** to the towering Edinburgh Castle. For whisky enthusiasts, we recommend a visit to the Whisky Experience, before enjoying a nice dinner at one of the many great restaurants in the city.

Spend another night in Edinburgh.

Attractions: Calton Hill, Edinburgh, Edinburgh Castle, Edinburgh New Town, Edinburgh Old Town, The Grassmarket, The Royal Mile & St Giles Cathedral

3

DAY 3: FAMOUS SCENES OF THE HIGHLANDS

Today, your guide will pick you up from your hotel in a quality private vehicle. The first stop is at the **Forth Rail Bridge**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, before visiting **Doone Castle**, featured in *Monty Python & the Holy Grail* and *Outlander*.

Later, you'll pass through Scotland's most iconic valley, **Glen Coe** before stopping for lunch at Clachaig Inn. Its stunning backdrop was used in films such as *Harry Potter*. The last stop before reaching the **Isle of Skye** is at the fabulous viewpoint of the **Spean Bridge Commando Memorial**.

Spend the night on the Isle of Skye.

Included: Entrance to Doone Castle

Driving distance: 378 km / 235 miles

Average travel & exploring duration: estimated 8 - 9 hours

Attractions: Callander, Doone Castle, Forth Railway Bridge, Glen Coe, Isle of Skye, Spean Bridge Commando Memorial

4

DAY 4: ISLAND OF SKYE

Today you can take advantage of a full day on Skye, a haven for nature lovers. You'll first travel along the northern part of the island, the breathtaking Trotternish Peninsula. Here you can take in the iconic sights such as The Old Man of Storr, the Quiraing, the Fairy Glen and Kilt Rock waterfall.

For lunch, you'll stop by the oldest inn on Skye, followed by a visit to the Skyeskyns traditional sheepskin tannery and a scenic afternoon walk on Neist Point, the most westerly point of the island with a beautiful cliff-top lighthouse.

Spend another night on Skye.

Driving distance: 170 km / 105 miles

Average travel & exploring duration: estimated 8 hours

Attractions: Fairy Glen, Kilt Rock & Mealt Falls, Lealt Falls, Neist Point, Old Man of Storr, Quiraing, Trotternish Peninsula

DAY

5

DAY 5: LOCH NESS & EILEAN DONAN CASTLE

Today, you head back to mainland Scotland and back to Edinburgh (you can choose to end your trip in Glasgow in the optional activities below). You'll first stop for some photos at Eilean Donan, the most photographed castle in Scotland, before continuing on to the mystical Loch Ness, where you can look for the elusive monster. Continuing south you'll stop at the Dalwhinnie Whisky Distillery for a tour and tasting and then head through the Cairngorms National Park through the Victorian town of Pitlochry.

Spend the night in Edinburgh.

Included: Entrance to Dalwhinnie Distillery

Driving distance: 395 km / 245 miles

Average travel & exploring duration: estimated 8 - 9 hours

Attractions: Cairngorms National Park, Dalwhinnie Distillery, Eilean Donan Castle, Fort Augustus, Loch Ness, Pitlochry

6

DAY 6: DEPARTURE

On your day of departure, a private driver will pick you up from your hotel to take you directly to the airport. If your flight is in the afternoon, you may take your last few hours to do some last-minute shopping, visit one of Edinburgh's many museums, or take one last stroll through the charming city centre.
